In compliance with Texas Code of Criminal Procedures Article(s) 2.133 and 2.134, attached please find a statistical report for Traffic and Pedestrian Stops — Racial Profiling, submitted to the Williamson County Commissioner's Court as the governing body for the Precinct 3 Constable's Office. This report reflects the period of January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018.

The Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) possesses the secured master-reporting format and analyzes spreadsheet. The Williamson County Precinct 3 Constable's Office submitted all required data to produce the results in the attached statistical report by TCOLE. The data collected is our required documentation of all public contacts, either by traffic or pedestrian stops, whereby individual(s) were detained by probable cause or reasonable suspicion for any alleged offense(s).

The totality of **444** Detentions reflect the following:

- 7.2% were African
- 2.4% were Asian
- 80.8% were Caucasian
- 8.3% were Hispanic
- 0% were Middle Eastern
- 1.1% were Native American

The data reflects no issues or concerns with racial profiling from the Precinct 3 Constable's Office.

Williamson County Constable Precinct 3 has adopted a detailed written policy on racial profiling. Our policy:

- 1.) clearly defines acts constituting racial profiling;
- 2.) strictly prohibit peace officers employed by the Williamson County Constable Precinct 3 from engaging in racial profiling;
- 3.) implements a process by which an individual may file a complaint with the Williamson County Constable Precinct 3 if the individual believes that a peace officer employed by the Williamson County Constable Precinct 3 has engaged in racial profiling with respect to the individual;
- 4.) provides public education relating to the agency's complaint process;
- 5.) requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the Williamson County Constable Precinct 3 who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the Williamson County Constable Precinct 3's policy adopted under this article;
- 6.) require collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a citation is issued and to arrests made as a result of those stops, including information relating to:
  - a.) the race or ethnicity of the individual detained;
  - b.) whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search; and

c.) whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before detaining that individual; and

7.) require the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision(6) to:

a.) the Commission on Law Enforcement; and

b.) the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.
