WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Williamson County is proud to recognize James Pogue and the service he has provided to the community of Liberty Hill; and


WHEREAS, James Pogue has unselfishly given his time for many years to not only the Volunteer Fire Department but also to Emergency Medical Services for our community; and
