There were deep ruts through the mud and large rocks left in the center between the ruts, as well as along the sides of the road. There was no choice except to follow the ruts to use the road.

We drive a '94 Pontiac Bonneville so the ruts alone were not a big problem, but with the high center and large rocks left where cars would hit them, we had a problem. The particular rock we hit punctured our oil pan and damaged the up-take tubes, disabling our car. Charles Canady had to order an oil pan for us and replace the oil which was lost. The bill was \$282.61 and we are requesting that the County reimburse us for this expense.

Hear comments from Commissioners.

Commissioner Boatright discussed the December 8, 1997, ATS meeting which consisted of public input for ranking the projects under ATS jurisdiction. Highway 71 which will be one of the main feeders from the new airport in Austin was #1, SH 30 was #2, 183 overhead and main lanes from Hunters Chase to north of 620 was #3.

TxDOT ranked the projects with 183 as #1, Highway 71 as #2 and 290 as #3 in terms of construction money. On February 28, 1998, the projects will be presented to the Highway Commission. The Commissioner felt we needed all the support we could line up for 183 & SH 45. TxDOT is ready to go out for bids in a very short period of time when 183 is approved.

Judge Doerfler was in agreement that Williamson County does need to develop a strong relationship with the Travis County Commissioners Court and work together on our traffic problems.

Commissioner Mehevec agreed with Judge Doerfler.

Commissioner Hays is holding a meeting regarding State Highway 130 in his office at 10:30 a.m. Thursday, December 11, 1997.

Judge Doerfler reminded the Commissioners of the 1:00 p.m. Wednesday, December 17, 1997, Special Board of Review meeting in Commissioners Courtroom pertaining to the Leander Development Plan. The Judge had communicated with the Land Office who assured him he would have a copy of the traffic in-put study in time for the meeting.

The Judge also discussed the large turn-out for the Williamson County Livestock Show and expressed his appreciation to Constables Wilson and Jaroszewski for their security services.

The Judge and Commissioners Boatright and Hays had inspected the current showbarn and discussed the need for expansion.
