PROPOSALS received after that time will be returned unopened. As to each item bid, the Court may either reject all PROPOSALS or award a contract to the lowest and best PROPOSAL. It is the intent of the Commissioners' Court to award contracts separately for each item, for each department, and for each distinct geographical area served by a department. PROPOSAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR JUVENILE SERVICES**RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT**

A residential treatment center shall be equipped to address a variety of emotional, psychological, or behavioral problems presented by the residents. Professional licensed (Ph. D. level) psychological and psychiatric staff shall be available to the residents on a routine or as needed basis. A residential treatment center should have clearly outlined and understandable behavior modification incentives built into the program, including the earning and loss of privileges. This will typically be accomplished through a daily point system. General expected behavioral/emotional outcomes and benefits for juveniles placed in a residential treatment center will include but not be limited to:

- * Increased ability to interact appropriately and positively with peers and adults (authority figures).
- * Increased skill and awareness to recognize personal stress and increasing emotional tension - demonstrate new ability to appropriately manage and resolve these states in a pro-social manner.
- * Increased ability to appropriately verbalize thoughts, feelings, and concerns to others while seeking a positive resolution to a presenting problem.

Parental and familial involvement in the juvenile's residential treatment program should be stressed and encouraged. Furloughs home and weekend visits may be earned at later stages in the program. Clearly outlined expectations will be presented to both the juvenile and parent(s) prior to such furloughs and visits.

Close supervision and monitoring of the resident's activities will be provided at all times, including 24 hour awake staff. A residential treatment center shall have an on-campus school program available with specially trained and skilled staff to handle severely emotionally disturbed youths. A public school setting may be utilized in later stages of the youth's treatment.

Minimum length of stay in a residential treatment center should be no less than 6 months, and typically should not exceed 12 months.




