WHEREAS, traffic demands in the north-south corridor between Williamson County and Travis County have increased significantly; and

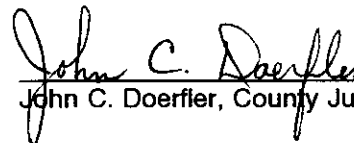
WHEREAS, TX 95 at Coupland has the only bridge that will pass the 100 year flood between IH 35 and the Milam County line; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation has approved replacement of the bridge at Brushy Creek as part of the planned improvement on FM 973; and

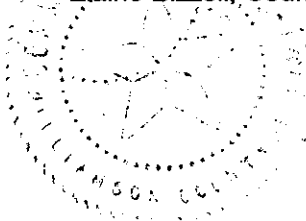

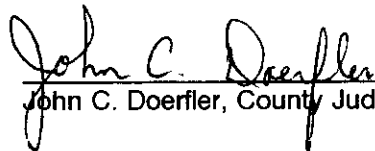
WHEREAS, traffic demands in the north-south corridor between Williamson County and Travis County
