Dear Sir:

I have been in conversation with Mr. Jim Avant, owner of the land both upstream and downstream of the proposed bridge on D.B. Wood Road, regarding the possibility of securing some fill material for the embankments on both ends of the bridge. He has agreed to sell the County that material at a cost of \$1.00/yd. Depending on the amount of material we get from the water line that is under construction, we may need approximately 8,000 cu. yds. The per yard price is probably higher than normal but there would be very little cost for hauling because the borrow site is immediately adjacent to the bridge.

Would you please put this item on the court agenda as soon as possible so I can alert potential contractors regarding this matter. You might want to leave this item on the court's agenda because there may be other issues that might arise that could need court action.

If the court agrees with this proposal, I will cross section the area so that the exact amount of material that is removed can be determined.

I have not to date received Mr. England's comments regarding the bridge plans. Hopefully I will receive them by next week.
