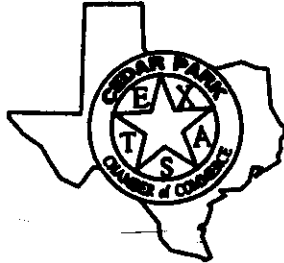

WHEREAS, the Cedar Park Chamber of Commerce supports improvements of transportation infrastructure for residents of Southwest Williamson County; and


WHEREAS, the Cedar Park Chamber of Commerce is committed to the long term economic growth and vitality of the Cedar Park area; and
