Hear any interested persons, consider forming the next agenda, or adding any emergency items to today's agenda.

George Gregory, President of the Ethel Barnes Association, an organization consisting of people in all areas of Williamson and surrounding counties which encourages and supports elected officials in their decision making. The goal of the organization is to ensure the citizens of Williamson County the local government utilizes their authority to protect the residents they represent, particularly pertaining to health and safety. Other priorities include septic systems, water run-off, water quality, traffic and road maintenance, over development and property values.

Also present from the Ethel Barnes Association were members Brenda Hall and Bill Rush.

Kenneth Schneider resident of Northridge Acres questioned the status of the step program concerning Northridge Acres.

Lisa Quay with the Brushy Creek Municipal Utility District thanked the court for their kindness and attention in matters concerning the MUD, and commended the court for their support in the Household Hazardous Waste Collection project.

Commissioner Heiligenstein stated the Northridge Acres project is not controlled by the county but by the homeowners association. The county has secured a grant for \$350,000.00 dollars for the project. A federal program requires voluntary community work and the county is not authorized to install water and sewer for any neighborhood.

Commissioner Boatright noted the closing of Bower Drive from Blue Ridge to Valley Pike on Sunday, May 17, 1998 from 3:00 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. for a block party.

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
