WHEREAS: The citizens of Jarrell strive to demonstrate their respect and appreciation for those who lost their lives and homes, and,


WHEREAS: The Jarrell Civic League and others have made complicated efforts to see that JARRELL MEMORIAL PARK become a reality, and,




