The definition of these geographic areas, unless expressly stated in this notice or the BID, shall be at the discretion of Commissioners' Court at the time a BID is awarded.

2. No more than one BID will be awarded for any item for a single department and area. All BIDS may be rejected for some items, departments or areas, even though awards are made for others. 
