

Commissioner Boatright reported on the ATS executive committee meeting last Friday on prioritizing road projects. He would like to have input from other commissioners on roads in ATS boundary before January 26, 1998.

Commissioner Hays stated EMS director John Sneed and he will be going to College Station to show the film on the Jarrell tornado at the County and District Judges conference.

Also, he reported on the NASCO planning retreat. Winnipeg Canada, Iowa, Kansas, Oklahoma and Texas were represented discussing long term goals. A resolution was passed in support of proposed SH 130. Border crossing at Laredo was discussed.

Commissioner Heiligenstein reported CUC had a good meeting last week. The jail backlog issue is coming up again and he wants to encourage the jail committee to proceed with haste.
