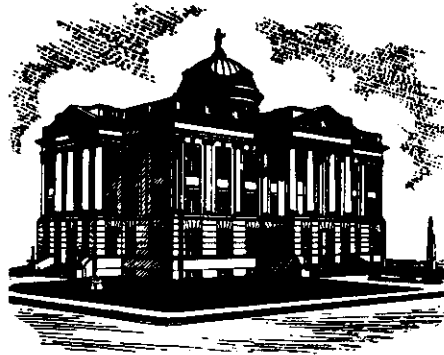

RE: CASH FUND FOR COLLECTION OF CRIMINAL FEES/FINES

Dear Judge Doerfler:

In order to reinstate the policy that payment for criminal fees and fines collected in the County Clerk's Criminal Section may be in cash, I am requesting that I receive an additional \$100.00 for that cash drawer.

In October, 1997, \$100.00 was returned to the County Treasurer's Office to be returned to the General Fund due to the fact that the County Clerk's Office ceased to take cash for payment of fines and court costs in that department.

It has been brought to my attention that this has become a problem with defendants and their attorneys in having to leave the Annex in order to purchase a cashier's check or money order for payment before being released. It is my opinion that if a defendant is offering to pay cash for court costs and/or fines then that cash needs to be taken at the time offered. This eliminates the possibility of a defendant leaving the building for the purchase of an accepted mode of payment and thus being tempted to not return.

I have discussed this with the County Court at Law Judges and they believe that this action could help expedite the process of disposing of some of the criminal cases. For example, the paper process could continue in a flow instead of having to stop for the defendant to go elsewhere for the purchase of a cashier's check or money order and then returning to court and the finalization of his or her paperwork.
