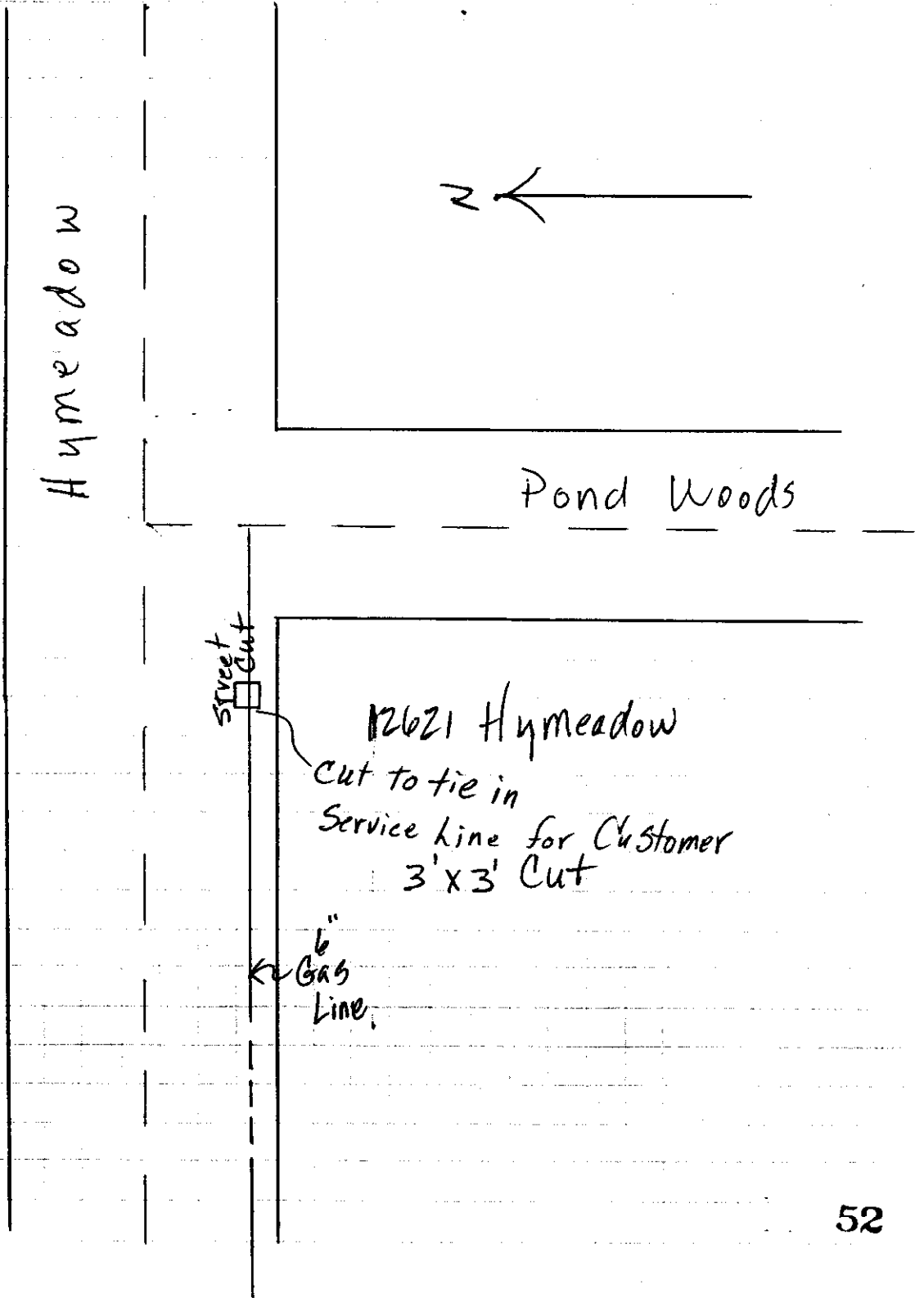

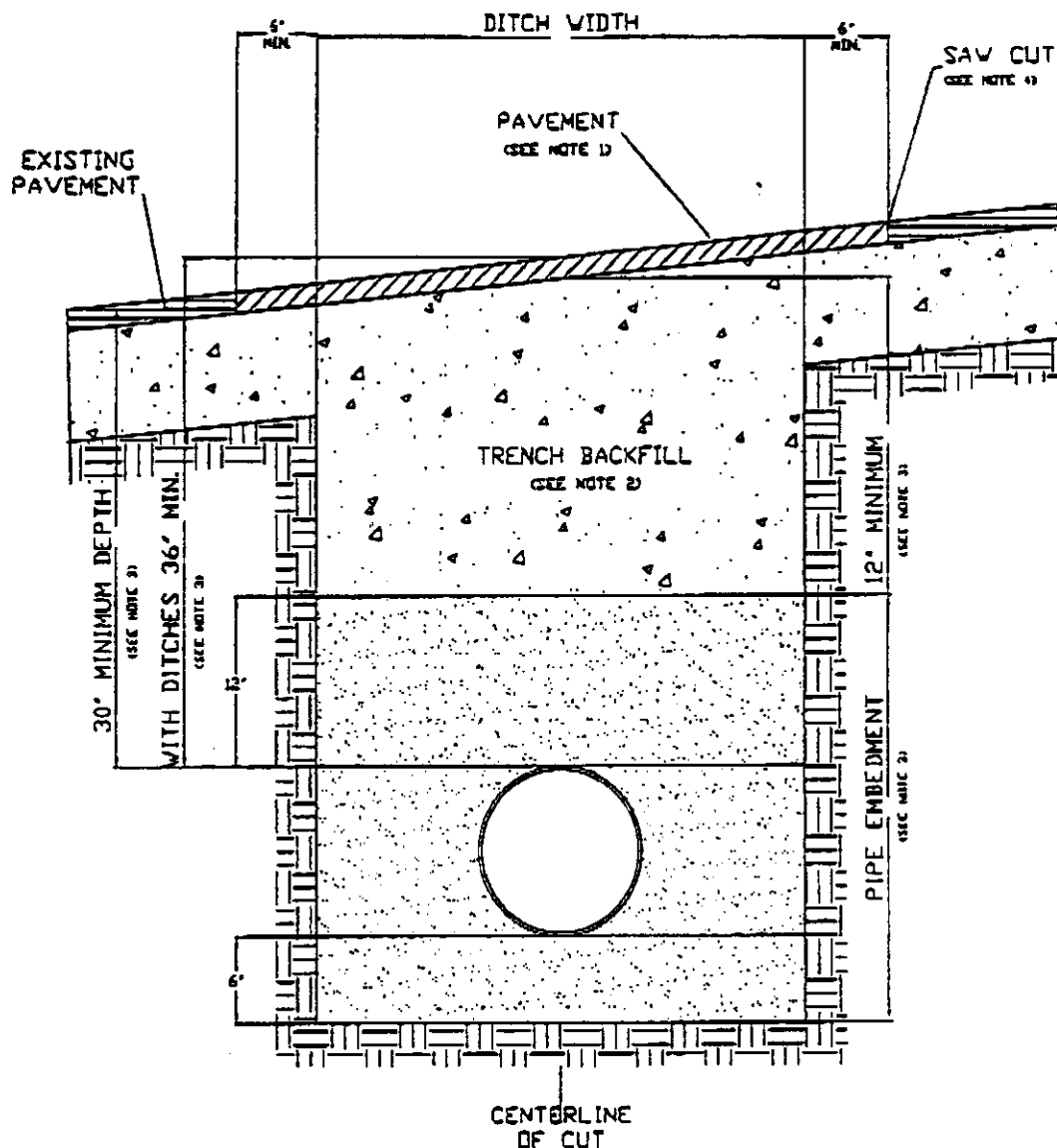


RESOLUTION
