As a former crossing guard on Park Valley for Fern Bluff Elementary, I can apprise first hand of the traffic problems that occur daily on Park Valley. I have witnessed too many close calls between cars and children on their way to school to count. It is a disaster waiting to happen! Speeding on Park Valley is constantly a problem even within the designated school zone. I have personally seen several car accidents as a result of speeding cars. I believe that the instillation of two stop signs would significantly slow down traffic in front of the school and through the neighborhood. Thank you for considering this request.

Dear Commissioner Hays:

As a resident of Fern Bluff for the past nine years, I have seen our neighborhood grow and change. But one thing that has not changed, except for the worst, is the speeding traffic. When the park was completed, I thought traffic would slow down, especially with the playscape so close to the road, but it did not. When the school opened, I thought the traffic would slow down, but again I was disappointed.

Park Valley is a busy street with excessive traffic. Most of that traffic travels well above the 30 MPH posted speed limit. There have been two accidents within the last two months on that road, both dealing with high speeds. The road has several curves in it and there are no signs warning that a school or park is ahead.

The residents are well aware of the school and park. What is needed are frequent stop signs along Park Valley, just like the ones on Deepwood in Round Rock West. Traffic would not be able to whiz through the neighborhood at high speeds if it was required to stop every few blocks.

A stop sign in front of the school is desperately needed. It is very difficult to make a left hand turn into the school or a left hand turn out of the school. Cars squeeze pass you on the right to go straight while you are waiting to turn. With a three way stop, everyone would have a turn and traffic would flow much better.

The crossing guard is at great risk when she tries to stop traffic for pedestrian traffic. The cars are coming from three different directions not to mention those trying to squeeze by. The cross walk should be moved away from that intersection and be placed in front of the school.

Thank you for considering this matter. We hope that some action will be taken soon, before someone gets hurt, or worse, killed.


Dear Commissioner Hays:

As PTA President for Fern Bluff Elementary School, one of the schools in the Round Rock ISD, I am very concerned about the traffic situation and the safety of our children. Fern Bluff opened the fall of 1992 with around 300 students. Today, enrollment is at 616. With new houses still being built, 1999 fall enrollment is projected to be 700. This growth is good for Williamson County. However, as I'm sure you're very much aware, growth is a mixed bag. Maintaining quality of life can be difficult. This is the case for the Fern Bluff Community.

With only 300 students and a small neighborhood, traffic was not a problem in 1992. Today, it has reached a critical level. While inconvenience is a fact of life, the safety of our children is my primary concern. Both Park Valley Drive, the street in front of the school, and Wyoming Springs, the road bordering the rear, have become serious safety zones. Motorists speed recklessly through this area, with little heed to speed or regulatory signs. I urge you to study this situation, and make immediate changes, before a serious accident occurs. My phone rings constantly and I am waylaid each time I visit the school by concerned parents. I am very concerned that if a child is hurt, there will be an explosive response, exacerbated by the fact that parents have repeatedly appealed to the authorities to consider this issue.

Commissioner Hays, please look into this matter with speed and urgency. The ire of Fern Bluff parents is well justified. They do not casually seek the safety of their children. Anything that you could do on the behalf of our children would be greatly appreciated and respected.


Dear Mr. Hayes,

The purpose of this letter is to express my concern, as well as represent the Fern Bluff community, regarding the traffic and access issues around the campus. For the past year and a half, we have continually brought violations of posted speed, bicycle lane, and parking restrictions around the campus, which interfere with our children's safety, to the attention of the Williamson County authorities. We have, as individuals, spoken to these concerns with city and county officials to no avail. The conditions persist and without exception, every governing body or other authority, e.g., sheriff, has refused to assist us in finding a solution for this persistent problem.

I am concerned that if the present conditions, under which traffic around the school flows, continues without regulation and enforcement, instead of near misses, we will experience a tragedy of great proportion. I speak of tragedy in terms of the life of a child. This would be unforgivable, especially since we have neglected to take a pro-active approach to these issues.

Please carefully consider my words and the representation of this issue by Fern Bluff community members appearing before you.
