We would like to film a music video for David Ball in Coupland, TX during daylight hours on Wednesday, December 16, 1998. We will be eating at Coupland Inn where David Ball is a regular. The following is a proposal for the filming (all times are approximate):

6am - 11am

1) At the intersection of Spur 277 and 1466 we propose to place the band in the center of the intersection using officers to allow intermittent traffic to go through the intersection and around our setup.

For this shot we will need to control the parking along 1466 going West into town so that we can place picture vehicles there.

11am - 3pm

2) The band and camera will be loaded onto a flat bed truck and driven along Hwy 95 in either direction using Coupland as our base. This will be a 'rolling road block,' we will be going slower than the speed limit but we will be moving with a sheriff escort, of course.


3pm - 6pm
