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Consider approving Mediation Settlement Week in March, 1999, and authorize funding from Dispute Resolution fund.

District Judge Carnes advised mediation week will be resumed during the conference in March, 1999. In the past the funding of administrative expenses for mediation week has been a problem. By statute a fund now exists which is dedicated to alternate dispute resolution but requires approval of Commissioners Court. The fund gathered in excess of \$7,800.00 last year with a present balance of approximately \$40,000.00. Judge Carnes requested \$1,500.00 to fund mediation settlement week in March, 1999.

The property is located at the intersection of Bowman Road and Farm-to-Market 1460 with dedication of an additional 10' right-of-way. Another 10' of right-of-way will be dedicated upon development of tract directly across Farm-to-Market 1460 for total right-of-way of 100 feet.

Jim Stendebach advised this is the second phase of assisted care facility on lot located immediately north of this lot. Both facilities are sharing a driveway so no road cuts will be necessary for Farm-to-Market 1460.

The County Engineer also advised the proposed extension of County Road 122 will be a major arterial roadway connecting with Heatherwold Boulevard and running to Yaeger Lane in Travis County.

I respectfully request your approval for Non-Paid Deputy Constable positions for the following individuals:


1. Edward Edison Thomison
