As you know, for the past 8 years, Church of the Hills has given a free gift to the community of Anderson Mill West in the form of a 4th of July Celebration. We are excited to announce that this will be our first year to host what we hope to be an Annual Christmas Party at the Anderson Mill West Park, another free gift to the community. This will be held in the setting of a 1940's town, with lots of good music, dramas, and food. We will also have a tree lighting to cap off the evening. This will be held December 4, with a set up and rehearsal on Friday, December 3

We have obtained permission for this event from the Severn Trent MUD # 1 to hold this event at the park. This will involve a trailer with a drama set built on it parked on the edge of the park on Dagama Street. We will have another small set on the edge of the street there also. These sets would not take up much more room than a parked car along the street would. The larger set I believe is 8' wide. All the other sets will be placed around the park grounds.


I am requesting permission from you on a couple points.

1. Permissions to park the trailer sets along the park on Dagama.
2. Since there is passage around the back of the school, would it be possible to block off Dagama from El Salido west to where the drive through goes behind the school from 4:00 p.m. until approximately 10:00 pm the evening of Dec. 4<sup>th</sup>? Due to the number of people who will be walking back and forth across the street from the parking areas at the school to the park, we felt that would be a good safety measure. We would be happy to set up detour signs to direct people around the school.
3. Would it be possible for us to take the speed limit sign off the pole on Dagama, near El Salido that is in the park? We would replace it as soon as the presentation is over. If this isn't possible, could we cover it with something that we could make look like it fits in with our 1940's theme?

I would be happy to get together with you or one of your representatives at the park to show you what we are wanting to do, or to further discuss this with you.
