Hear any interested person and consider forming the next agenda or adding items to today's agenda.

Captain Shawn Newsom clarified the Sheriff Department 12 training officers pay structure requests for the 1999/2000 budget. The budget requested retention of the 12 Field Training Officers **in addition** to the Corporal positions participating in training.

Mr. Darrell Champeau of Cedar Park again discussed the YMCA management of Hog Farm. He suggested a conflict of interest of Commissioner Heiligenstein who serves on the management board of The Hill Country YMCA controlling the park.

Mr. Champeau requested Commissioners Court issue a temporary restraining order against the YMCA requesting removal of all "no trespassing - private property" signs as well as those signs claiming YMCA ownership of the park. Further, keep gate open and unlocked during daylight hours and discontinue charging an entrance fee.

Commissioner Heiligenstein advised he is not now nor has he ever been a member of the Hill Country YMCA managing board of directors.

Commissioner Heiligenstein advised he **is** on the advisory board of the YMCA **Round Rock** facility.
