Company proposes to place a 3/4" waterline in a 4" casing

line within the right-of-way of County Road 245

The existing waterline is on the East side of County Road 245, 28' from the pavement, buried 36" deep. The width of the pavement is 21' and the depth of the road bore to be made is 36".
