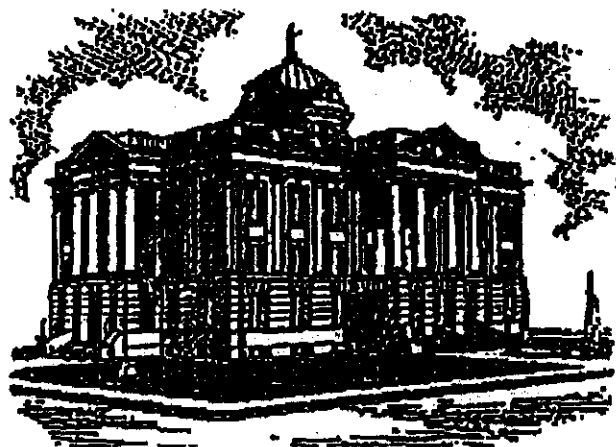

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I respectfully request your consideration and approval of Mr. Bernard Miller Tippie III as non-paid deputy for the Precinct Three Constable's staff. This item is requested for the next possible Commissioner's Court agenda.

Mr. Tippie has held a non-paid Deputy position with the Williamson Co. Sheriff's Department for the past two years in good standing. However, Mr. Tippie desires to pursue his law enforcement career with more emphasis in fugitive apprehension and civil law issues, and less criminal law enforcement as addressed by the Precinct Three Constable's Office.

The background investigation revealed Mr. Tippie to be a mature and dedicated individual with good people skills and good problem solving skills. He is highly regarded to have a strong personal and work ethic, interact with the public professionally and exercises common sense.

His education and experience would enable him to work independently as a basic peace officer with minimal training and orientation to Constable duties and responsibilities. His appointment would assist our office with our aggressive warrant – fugitive apprehension program and high volume civil law workload.

In light of recent voluntary resignations of non-paid deputies, Mr. Tippie's appointment would bring my office to a staffing level of three (3) non-paid deputies to complement the full-time staff.
