WHEREAS, The Williamson County Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Williamson County, that the JP/JPO Program be operated for the 2nd year; and

WHEREAS, Williamson County Commissioners Court has considered the proposed application for State and Federal Assistance for said project, in the amount of \$29,653.00 to be submitted to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, Fund JJDP Program; and

WHEREAS, The Williamson County Commissioners Court has agreed to provide matching moneys for the said project in the amount of \$7,414.00, or an amount equal to one-fourth of the total project cost, as required by the grant application; and

WHEREAS, The Williamson County Commissioners Court has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, Williamson County Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Williamson County Commissioners Court approves submission of the grant application for the JP/JPO Program in the amount of \$37,067.00.
