Consider approving agreement with K. C. Engineering for work on County Road. 404.

Commissioner Limmer advised 3348 in the agreement should read 3349 and 973 is listed as 923. He is proposing to use a portion of the \$22.5M certificate of obligation funds in his precinct. County Road 404 has an increasing amount of traffic between Farm to Market 973 and Farm to Market 3349 causing County Road 404 to need repairs. About mid-way on County Road 404 a five hundred (500) acre subdivision is being developed. The commissioner advised he is seeing increasing engineering and surveying expenses on the east side of the county and suggested the costs on the west side would be even more costly. Commissioner Limmer is satisfied with the costs of this agreement with K.C. Engineering.

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INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

The City of Georgetown wishes to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Williamson County Road and Bridge to perform some drainage work in various locations in the City of Georgetown. The City of Georgetown agrees to reimburse Williamson County for approximately 32 hours of work performed by one G3WD Gradall machine and one operator. The equipment rental fee for the Gradall is \$31.25 per hour and the operators' fee is \$16.50 per hour (includes benefits).
