Jeff Davis, host of the Jeff Davis television program and the national radio network for the past three (3) years, advised he is investigating several reports and allegations of abuse in Williamson County, Texas, by Round Rock, and Georgetown police departments as well as the Williamson County Sheriff's Department. Also charges for expired inspection stickers, heavy fines, long probation time and jail time for crimes against the State of Texas.

Mr. Davis distributed a video containing over 100 testimonials to the court. He asked the court members to review the two (2) hour video and conduct a public response in two (2) weeks. Copies had been distributed to Williamson County Sheriff Ed Richards, Travis County Sheriff Margo Frazier, Travis County Commissioners Court, Travis County Judge Sam Biscoe as well as Sam Davis.

Mr. Davis also advised he had been unable to receive a response from Sheriff Ed Richards, or District Attorney Ken Anderson.

Georgetown resident Charles Hernandez stated a petition is being distributed to Williamson County residents for signatures to show support and concerns of the video allegations. Upon completion the petition will be delivered to Commissioners Court.

Mike Hanson participated in compiling the video, urged the county to keep in mind why this country was founded. and urged the court to take some action.
