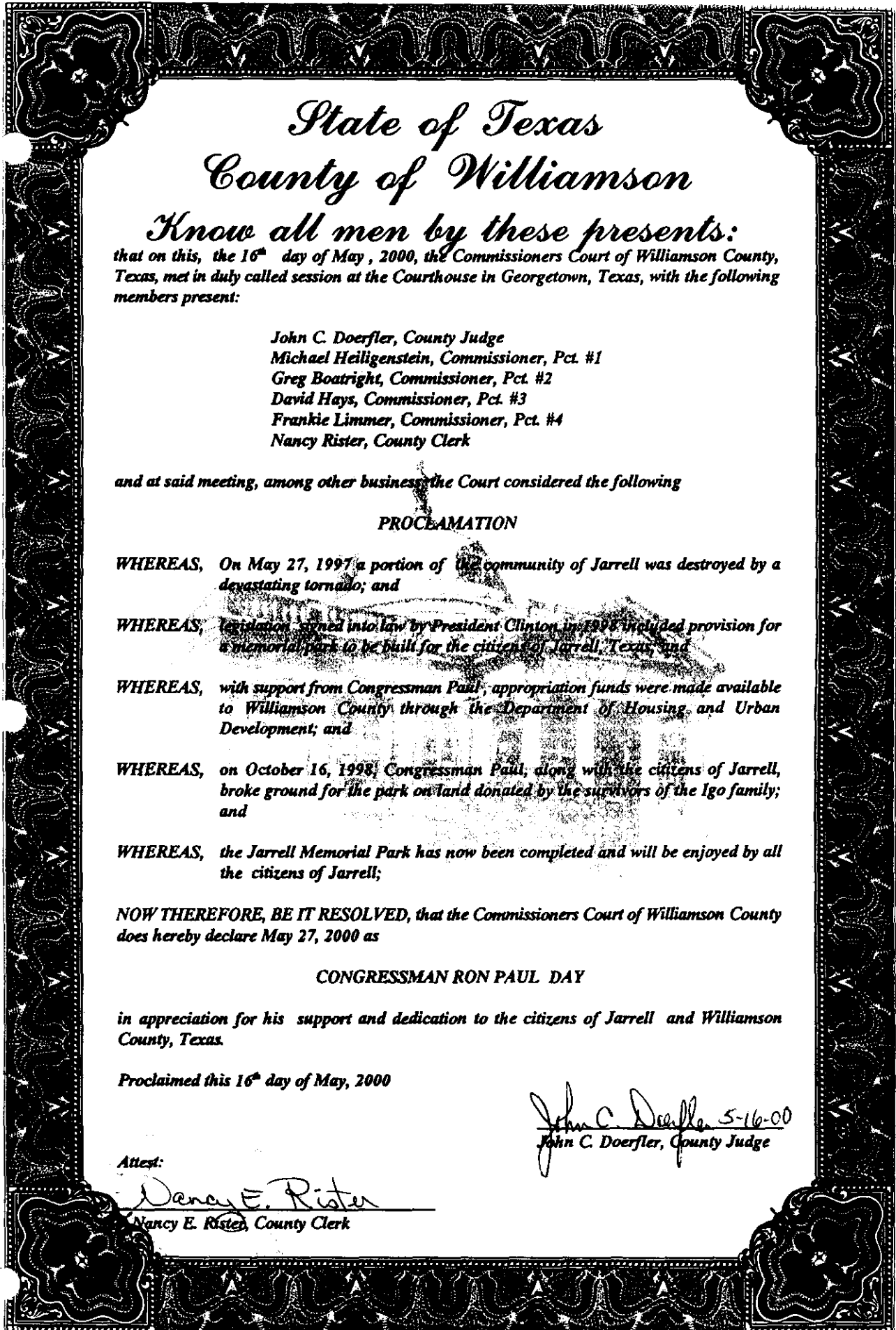

## RESOLUTION SUPPORTING REVIEW AND ASSESSMENT OF EMPLOYMENT AND HOUSEHOLD PROJECTIONS FOR SOUTHERN WILLIAMSON COUNTY

**WHEREAS**, development in southern Williamson County is occurring at a phenomenal rate; and,

**WHEREAS**, existing business, employment centers and homes have added vehicular traffic to an overburdened transportation infrastructure; and,

**WHEREAS**, effective long range planning for infrastructure projects depends upon the most accurate of employment and household information; and,

**WHEREAS, previous projections for Southern Williamson and Northern Travis County do not appear to have been based upon accurate existing household and employment data nor do these projections consider current development projects under construction or soon to be under construction; and,**

**WHEREAS**, the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization ("CAMPO") and the Texas Water Development Board are responsible for the most accurate long range planning projections and development of the region's long-range transportation plan based on those projections; now,
