Discuss and take appropriate action on the Southwest Williamson County Road District #1, including but not limited to payment of bills.

Attorney Charles Crossfield recommended the \$18,387.98 (remaining 50% of delinquent assessments collected March 1 through 31, 2000, by McCreary, Veselka, Bragg & Allen, P.C.) be deposited to the road district account. Then place an order with the Williamson County Appraisal District to prepare a map of the road district properties, property owners and amount due road districts with their Geographical Information System.
