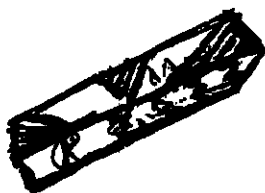

Re: 2000 Hairy Man Festival Road Closures

On Saturday, October 21st from 12:00 until 7:00pm, the Brushy Creek Women's Forum is once again sponsoring the Hairy Man Festival for the Brushy Creek community. The festival is a charitable family event benefiting area food banks serving Williamson County, the Hill County, and north rural Travis County. Local school clubs, civic groups, charities, and homeowner associations also sponsor several dozen booths as fund-raisers for their organizations.

We are requesting permission to close the following road from 11:00am until 8:00pm:

- Northbound O'Conner Blvd from Liberty Walk to E. Dorman allowing 2-way traffic on the southbound side and a section of Liberty Walk from Manx to O'Conner.

"NO PARKING" signs also need to be placed along the park side of Liberty Walk to reserve space for the EMS and fire vehicles. I will be contacting the Williamson County Unified Road System office regarding materials including the traffic directional signage. *Commitments have also been obtained from Star Flight, the Williamson County EMS and the Sam Bass Fire Department for the duration of the festival.*
