WHEREAS, the American Cancer Society recommends women aged 20-39 perform monthly breast self-examinations and have a breast examination performed by a health professional every three years; and

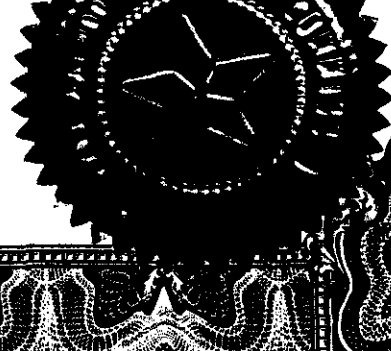
