Dear Judge Doerfler:

I recently received notification from the Department of Justice (DOJ) that Williamson County has yet to apply for a grant under the Local Law Enforcement Block Grants (LLEBG) program. The DOJ's Bureau of Justice Assistance, which determines eligibility for this law enforcement assistance program, has calculated that Williamson County may be eligible to receive up to \$41,817.

As you may know, LLEBG funds can be used to hire additional police officers or pay current officers overtime, purchase law enforcement equipment and technology, establish or support drug courts, enhance security at schools, establish multi-jurisdictional task force, establish crime prevention programs, and prosecute violent offenders. According to the DOJ, applications **must** be filled out **online** at [www.ojp.usdoj.gov/BJA/html/llebg1.htm](http://www.ojp.usdoj.gov/BJA/html/llebg1.htm).

The deadline for completing an LLEBG application has been extended through **October 20**. If you have any questions about funding through the LLEBG grant program, please contact me or *(\*)* John Wyatt of my staff at 202/224-2934.
