Leo Wood spoke about the allocation, and said that it would be possible to get full funding for the project next year if the county went forward with the design plans. He urged the court to accept the \$243,000 for the plans and specifications and then make a full application for total restoration for next year. Judge Doerfler stated that the total cost of the design plans will be \$450,000.00, exceeding the grant amount of \$243,000.00.

Dear Mr. Boatwright,

As you know, last year was our first annual "Christmas in Chihuahua Falls" event at the Anderson Mill West Park on El Salido. Chihuahua Falls is a 1940's town, with lots of good music, dramas, food and all around entertainment. We will also have a tree lighting to cap off the evening. This is a free family event for the Anderson Mill West neighborhood. Our event will take place December 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>, with set up on Thursday, Nov. 30, and tear down on Sunday, Dec. 3.

We have obtained permission from the Severn Trent MUD # 1 to hold this event at the Anderson Mill West Park again this year. This will involve a trailer with a drama set built on it parked on the edge of the street facing the park on Dagama Street. The set is approx. 8' wide. All the other sets will be placed around the park grounds.

I am requesting permission from you on the following points:

1. Permissions to park the trailer/set along the park on Dagama.
2. Since there is passage around the back of the school, we would again like to block off Dagama from El Salido west to where the drive through goes behind the school from 4:00 p.m. until approximately 10:00 pm the evening of Dec. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>. Due to the number of people who will be walking back and forth across the street from the parking areas at the school to the park, we felt that would be a good safety measure. We would be happy to set up detour signs to direct people around the school. We have used blockades from the road and bridge group in the past.
3. Would it again be possible to cover the speed limit sign at the edge of the park on Dagama near El Salido with a sign that looks like it fits in with our 1940's theme during our event? We have the wooden framed cover we used last year that we would use again.
