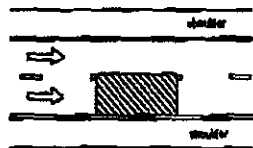
It is to my understanding that the City of Round Rock will have to approve/pass their Council for the construction speed reduction to be put in place.

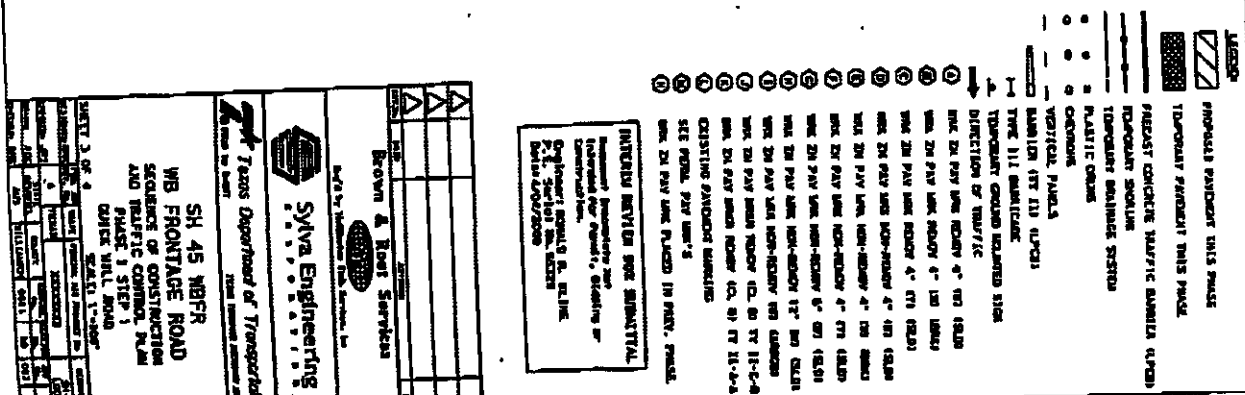

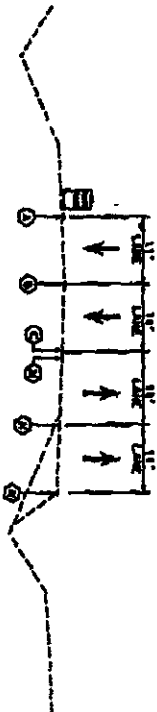

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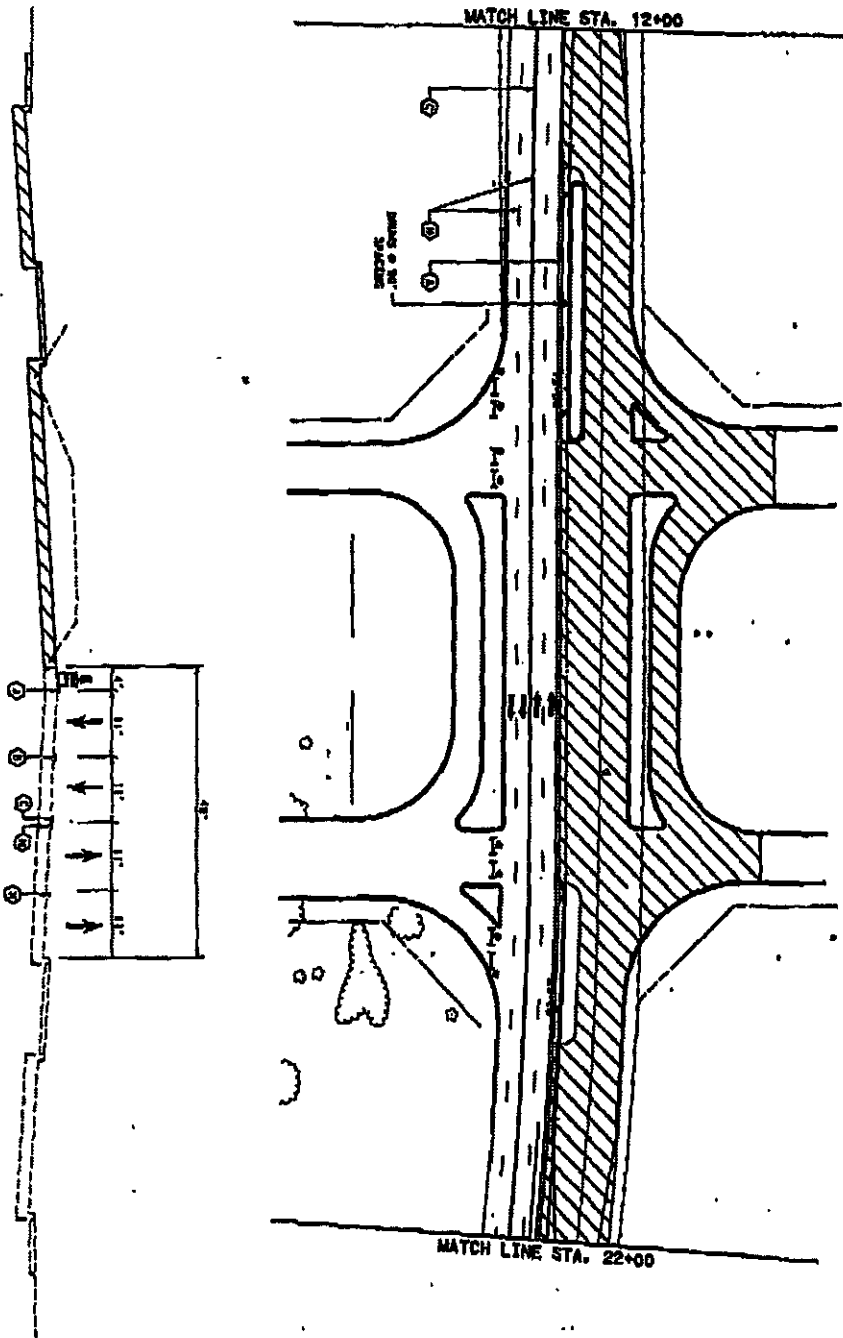
