These bids would include the transfer of one county canine unit (Arco) for the purpose of a discount toward the purchase of a new canine unit. Jane,
Would you please print this message and give it to David for court this morning. Thanks.

David,
Sorry I can't be in court this morning. I'm in Austin and can't get there on time. If it will help, feel free to relay my message to the court.

One of the services that the Health District provides is to link people who need medical care to physicians and clinics. Our experience is that there are not enough providers in Williamson County to provide care to the people who need it. Very few physicians or clinics are accepting new patients with Medicaid or CHIP (Children's Health Insurance Program) coverage. Many of these children are assigned to doctors in Austin and they have a hard time getting there because of lack of transportation. The Round Rock Health Clinic provides care to many of these children. Assessment data indicates that nearly 20% of the population in Williamson County does not have health insurance. The majority of these folks are working, but don't have access to insurance for a variety of reasons and need to have access to services on a sliding scale fee basis. Currently, the Clinic at Johns Community Hospital in Taylor is the only clinic offering a sliding scale fee. The volunteer Hill Country Medical Ministries Clinic in Cedar Park offers free care to a limited number two evenings a week. The proposed Georgetown Community Clinic will be a valuable resource to help fill this gap in care and is greatly needed in this county.
