INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

The City of Weir, Texas wishes to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Williamson County Road and Bridge to do some pot hole patching on several streets within the city limits of Weir and to seal coat (single course) the streets within the city limits of Weir that are listed on Attachment A.

The City of Weir agrees to reimburse Williamson County \$751.00 for the pot hole patching and \$7,681.70 for the seal coat work, for a total reimbursement of \$8,432.70.
