**WHEREAS,** the Jarrell High School Cougars were 25 2A bi-district champions in their 2000 season;

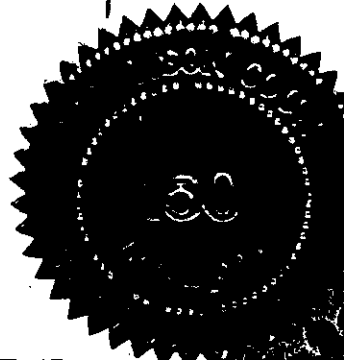
