INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into by and between the following parties: Travis County, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, and Williamson County, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, pursuant to Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, concerning interlocal cooperation contracts.

WHEREAS, Travis County intends to submit to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, Texas Narcotics Control Program, a grant application for state and federal assistance for the Capitol Area Narcotics Task Force in the total amount of \$985,611; and,

WHEREAS, Williamson County desires to participate in the Capitol Area Narcotics Task Force and to receive \$104,700 in CJD grant funds for two Williamson County Sheriff's Office investigators who will be assigned to the Task Force during the current grant period; and,

WHEREAS, Williamson County agrees to contribute the total of \$ 26,175 in matching funds if said application is approved; and,

WHEREAS, Williamson County and Travis County believe it to be in their best interest to cooperate in the operation of the Capitol Area Narcotics Task Force; and

WHEREAS, Williamson County and Travis County agree to adhere to all applicable federal, state, and local laws or regulations.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:**ARTICLE I
PURPOSE**

- 1.01 The purpose of this Agreement is to allow Williamson County and Travis County to jointly participate in a multijurisdictional task force under the Texas Narcotics Control Program pursuant to a grant from the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.

**ARTICLE II
TERM**

- 2.01 The term of this Agreement is to commence on the execution of this Agreement and to end May 31, 2002.
