


1. The items, which are the subject of this request, are abandoned or unclaimed property, as defined in Article 18.17, Texas Code of Criminal Procedure.

**PROCLAMATION**

**WHEREAS, the health of Williamson County communities is linked to the health and well-being of all the people throughout the County; and**

**WHEREAS, April 2-8, 2001 has been established as National Public Health Week-an occasion to educate and inform, to encourage increased community health education; and**
