
Re: Request to abandon County easement in Coupland, Texas

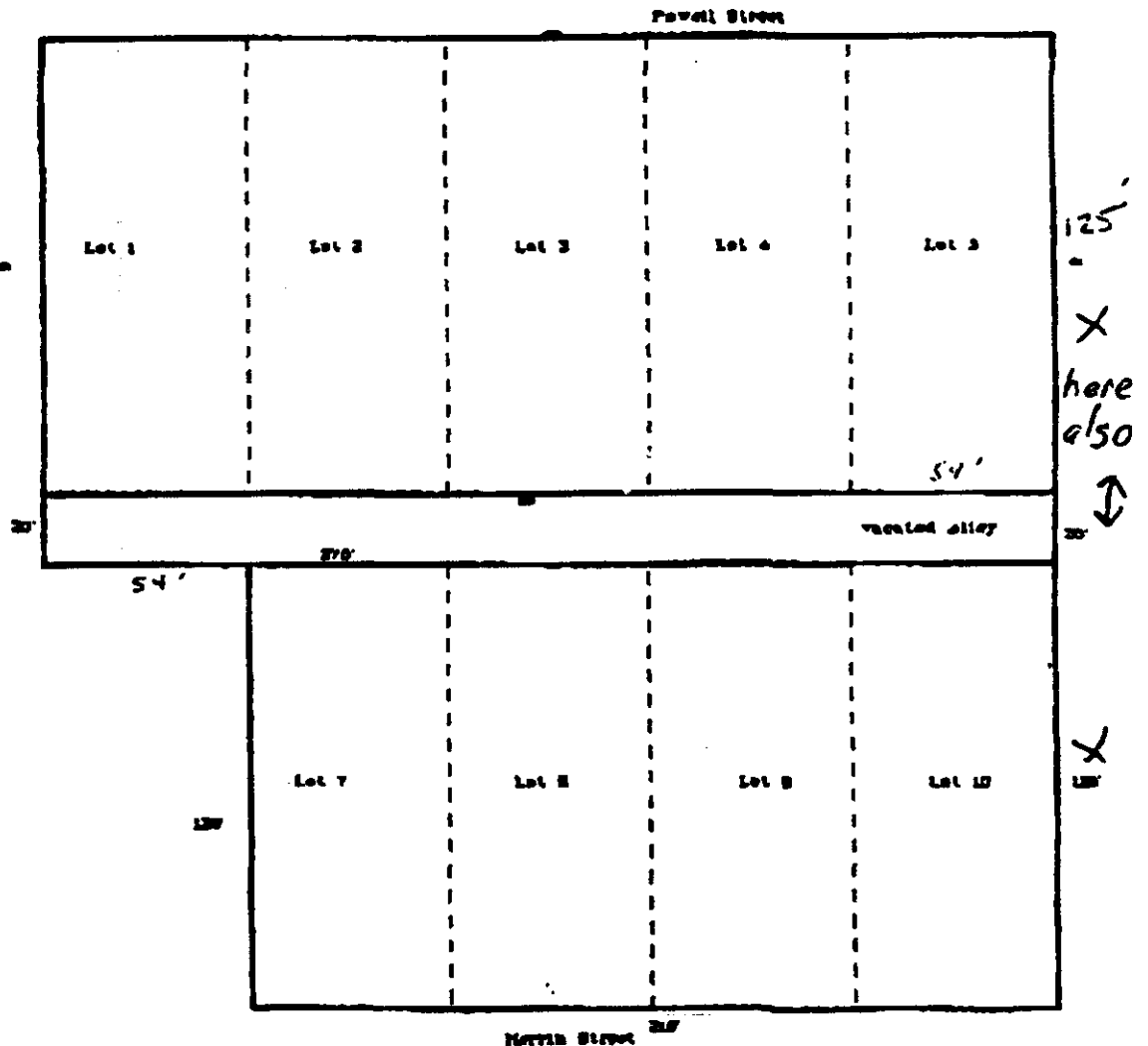
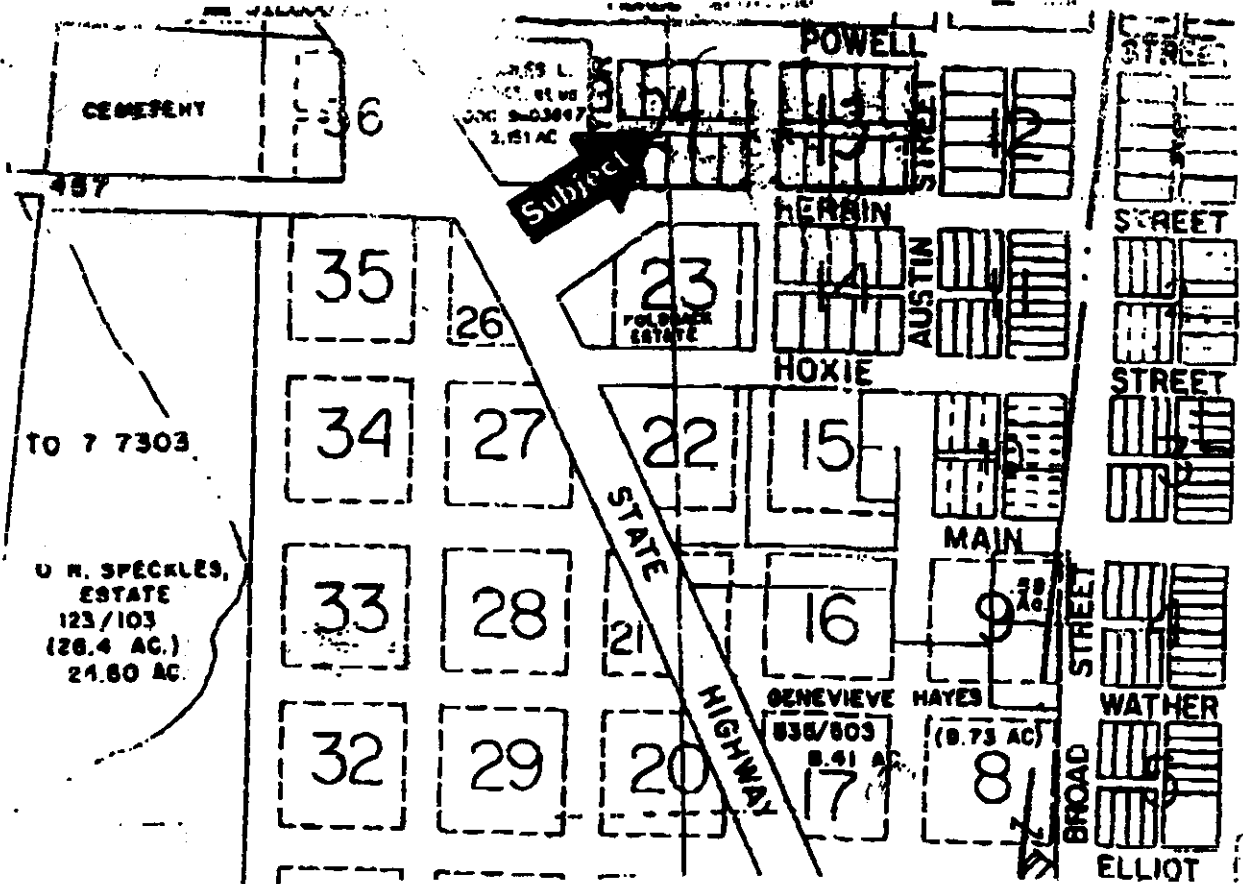
