WHEREAS, the people of Williamson County benefit daily from the knowledge and skills of these highly trained individuals and from the availability of the Texas Trauma Network; and



NOW THEREFORE, *be it proclaimed by the Williamson County Commissioner's Court that the month of May be*


"YOUTH ALCOHOL AWARENESS MONTH"
