NOW THEREFORE, *be it proclaimed by the Williamson County Commissioner's Court that the month of May be*

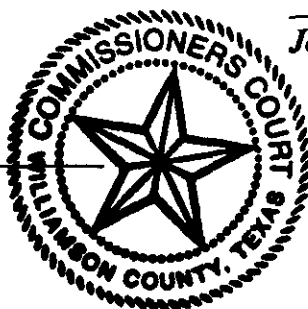
"YOUTH ALCOHOL AWARENESS MONTH"
