Date: April 25, 2001Formal notice is hereby given that Southwestern Bell TelephoneCompany proposes to place a Telephone cable (BURIED)line within the right-of-way of Brushy Creek Rd.
as follows: (give location, length, general design, etc.)

Beginning at an existing telephone manhole located on the north side of Brushy Creek Rd. and approximately 500 feet east of the intersection with S. Lynnwood Trail. We propose placing a copper cable and a spare pipe in a westerly direction for some 250 feet before entering a public utility easement in Forest Oaks Subdivision. An alignment of seven feet south of the R. O. W. Line is proposed. We propose crossing the concrete drainage area by boring under it. See attached work order # 4896983.

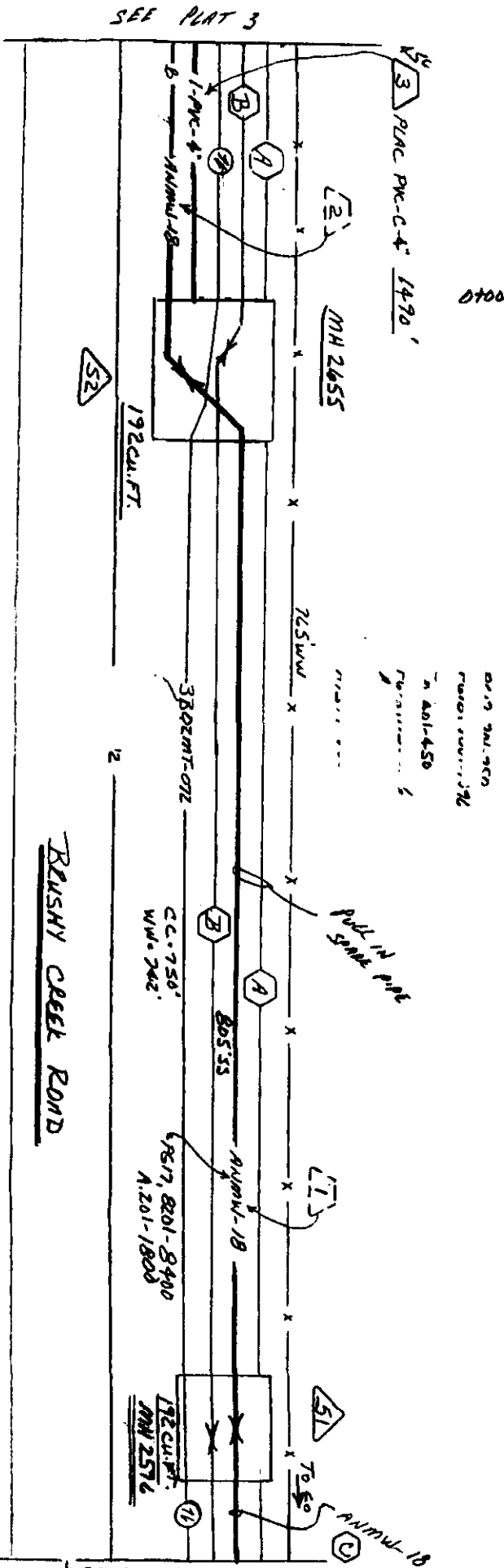
