RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, *in Spanish colonial exploration of Texas in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries carried out in large part by explorers, missionaries and soldiers, and*

WHEREAS, *much of this exploration followed previously established Indian Trails to which the explorers, soldiers, and missionaries gave the name Camino Real de los Tejas; and*

WHEREAS, *throughout the colonial period the Camino Real served as the majority artery of communication between Mexico and Texas; and*

WHEREAS, *the Texas Historical Commission, Texas colleges and universities have promoted learning and understanding of the vital importance of the state's Spanish colonial history; and*

WHEREAS, *citizens of the State of Texas and various public and local government entities have promoted the Camino Real de los Tejas as a National Historic Trail; now*

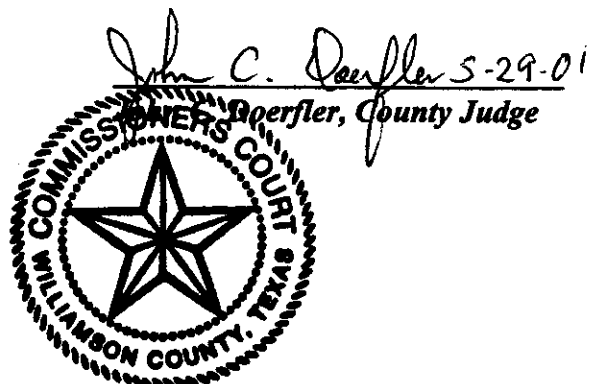
