AN ORDER DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND A GRAVE PUBLIC NECESSITY DUE TO UNFORESEEABLE CIRCUMSTANCES AND APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR

WHEREAS, THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT HAS CAREFULLY STUDIED THE PUBLIC NECESSITY OF INCREASING THE ESTIMATED REVENUES DURING THIS FISCAL YEAR; AND

WHEREAS, THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT, DUE TO UNFORESEEABLE CIRCUMSTANCES, DID NOT ESTIMATE SUFFICIENT FUNDS IN THE CURRENT BUDGET FOR THESE NECESSARY REVENUES; NOW

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT THAT AN EMERGENCY AND GRAVE PUBLIC NECESSITY DOES EXIST DUE TO UNFORESEEABLE CIRCUMSTANCES.

WHEREAS, ON THE 2nd DAY OF October, 2001, ~~1999~~, A MOTION MADE BY Commissioner Heiligenstein AND SECONDED BY Commissioner Limmer THE MOTION CARRIED BY A VOTE OF 5 FOR, 0 AGAINST.

WHEREAS, THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT HAS DECLARED AN EMERGENCY AND A GRAVE PUBLIC NECESSITY DUE TO UNFORESEEABLE CIRCUMSTANCES IN THE MATTER OF ESTIMATING NECESSARY FUNDS FOR THE ABOVE MENTIONED DEPARTMENT; NOW

Re: Texas Parks and Wildlife Semi-Annual Grants

The County Master Plan should be completed in November of this year. This will allow the county to gain an additional 20 points on any grant application we submit for Williamson County.

**The next grant cycle will require a grant application to be submitted around the end of December.**

There are two programs that the county could submit grant applications for:

Indoor facility

Outdoor facility

It is recommended that the county make application for each of these categories. **It is recommended, however, that the county make only one application for each.** Additional applications would dilute the importance of the project and could mean the loss of the grant competition.

I stand ready to assist in the grant application process for any or all projects the commissioners wish to apply for.
