**SCOPE OF WORK FOR SOURCE REMOVAL OF AIR CONVEYANCE SYSTEM
COMPONENTS COMPOSED OF POROUS OR NON-POROUS DUCT WORK**

- I. Supply Ductwork
 - A. Source removal process will be used to clean ductwork. Debris, dust and particulates will be removed by physical contact with a soft vacuum brush attached to our HEPA Vacuum System in conjunction with the Steamatic Negative Air machine and air washing devices.
 - B. Access openings will be cut as needed to provide entry points for source removal, visual inspection sights and treatment of biological contaminants.
 - I. Supply Registers/Return Air Grills
 - A. All supply registers/return air grills will be removed, hand cleaned, sanitized and replaced. If either is affixed to structure then it will be cleaned in place.
 - B. Area around supply register/return air grill will be vacuumed.
 - C. All supply registers will be covered with a poly filter material during the treatment process. This will be removed after these processes have been completed.
 - I. HVAC Equipment
 - A. Clean interior/exterior of housing surfaces.
 - B. Clean coils, drain pan and frame.
 - C. Clean all fans and related components.
 - D. Powerwash fresh air louvers and stoops
 - I. Chemicals
 - A. Steamatic 828 Cleaner
 - B. Steamatic Coil Cleaner
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- I. Equipment
 - A. Steamatic Negative Air Machine
 - B. Steamatic Air Washing Equipment
 - C. Max Vac (HEPA VACUUM)
 - D. Steamatic IES Compressed Spray System
 - E. Steamatic Duct Auger
 - F. Air Scrubber
 - G. Hepa Vacuum
 - I. Safety
 - A. Blackmon Mooring Steamatic and its employees will be familiar with and adhere to all appropriate OSHA and NIOSH safety procedures. This includes working conditions, equipment, and safety equipment.

 - B. Blackmon Mooring Steamatic cannot be held responsible for recontamination of supply and/or return air ducts due to filter maintenance, improper air mixture and contaminated dead air space..
 - C. Blackmon Mooring Steamatic recognizes NADCA Standard 1992-01 which address the mechanical cleaning air conveyance system components composed of non-porous materials.
 - D. Blackmon Mooring Steamatic agrees to perform these services during nite or weekend hours as needed.
 - E. Blackmon Mooring Steamatic cannot be responsible for chipped or cracked paint during the removal and replacement of the registers and grills.
 - F. Due to the ceilings access in building, it may become necessary to remove parts of the ceiling to gain access to hvac ductwork. BMS will not be responsible for broken tiles or replacement of tiles.
 - G. BMS will be given access to a storage room to have equipment left on site during cleaning operation..

GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS:

The Criminal Justice Center (CJC) is a two story building with a small basement and attic totaling approximately 71,700 square feet. There are thirty-four (34) air handling units located in sixteen (16) mechanical rooms. There are four (4) fresh air units located on the roof with hot water coils for heating during cold weather.

1. Air Handling Units:
 - a. Clean coils, drain pan and frame
 - b. Clean all fans and related components
 - c. Clean interior of housing units
 - d. Remove or render harmless biological contaminants
 - e. Treat the interior of the housing with a Biocide
2. Supply and Return Ductwork
 - a. Supply and return ductwork will be cleaned using the source removal process
 - b. Treat the interior of the duct with a biocide that is environmentally safe and Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) registered
 - c. Cut access opening as necessary to allow for source removal and treatment. There are numerous access doors already installed.
3. Fresh Air Units
 - a. Clean fans, interior of housing and related components
 - b. Clean heating coils
 - c. Fresh air ductwork will be cleaned using the source removal process
 - d. Treat interior of ductwork with a biocide
4. Chemicals: Must be environmentally safe and EPA registered. Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) must be provided on all chemicals. See Items 30 and 31 in the bidder instructions concerning hazardous chemicals (page 8).
5. Special Conditions and Requirements
 - a. Williamson County will provide on site personnel at all times for security and access to areas as needed
 - b. Work is to be performed after 6:00pm and completed by 6:00am, Monday through Friday and all day Saturday and Sunday. This is an operating court house with trials that may run into the night. Coordination must be made on a daily basis so both the operation of the courts and the cleaning of the systems will not interfere with each other.
6. Other
 - a. Mechanical blue prints will be provided
 - b. Walk through may be scheduled
