After re-inventorying the purse we arrived with the following damaged and lost items:


One Dooney and Bourke purse, damaged, valued at \$300.00



## Describe Incident:

Medic 12 transported Linda Bushover to RR Hosp for a possible fractured hip. The patient was treated and transported without incident. While treating, cleaning, and preparing unit we found the pt's purse in the front seat. It was removed from the truck and placed on the rear bumper until unit was back in service. The system was busy and Medic 12 was needed South Central. The purse was overlooked and we left the hospital. This was approximately 17:45. At approximately 20:00 we had transported another patient to Round Rock hospital when we were notified of the missing purse. We immediately checked with RR Hosp security but no purse had been found. Contacted EMS 10 for guidance. Then spoke with patient and spouse about the accidental loss of the purse. Medic 12 left and went to central fire station and contacted RR dispatch to see if they had any reports of the purse being found. George with RR dispatch states that Robert Ward had called him with the following info and request.


