Please be aware that the WBCO Board of Directors has tentatively approved the naming of the new Georgetown Head Start/Early Head Start facility the "Rawleigh Elliott Head Start Center", and the Taylor Head Start/Early Head Start facility the "Harris-Ross Head Start Center" with a request for concurrence by the City and County.

The Georgetown center's proposed name honors the memory of the first Executive Director of WBCO, former mayor of Georgetown and long-time community leader Rawleigh Elliott. The Taylor center's proposed name honors the first Taylor Head Start center director, Etna Mae "Mama" Harris, and long-time center director Senora Ross. Our plan would be to name the Early Head Start wing the "Harris Wing" and the Head Start wing the "Ross Wing".

We are confident that you will all agree that these citizens contributed immeasurably to our communities, and deserve recognition for their efforts.
