Company proposes to place a BURIED COMMUNICATION

line within the right-of-way of COUNTY ROAD 120
as follows: (give location, length, general design, etc.)

BEGINNING AT AN EXISTING POLE & PED IN THE
WEST ROW; BORE UNDER CO RD 120 IN AN
EASTERLY DIRECTION TO THE EAST ROW AND

the structure of this road or right-of-way, this line,
if affected, will be moved at the direction of the
Williamson County Engineer or County Commissioner.
This installation work shall not damage any part of the
roadway and adequate provisions shall be made to
cause a minimum of inconvenience to traffic and adjacent
property owners.

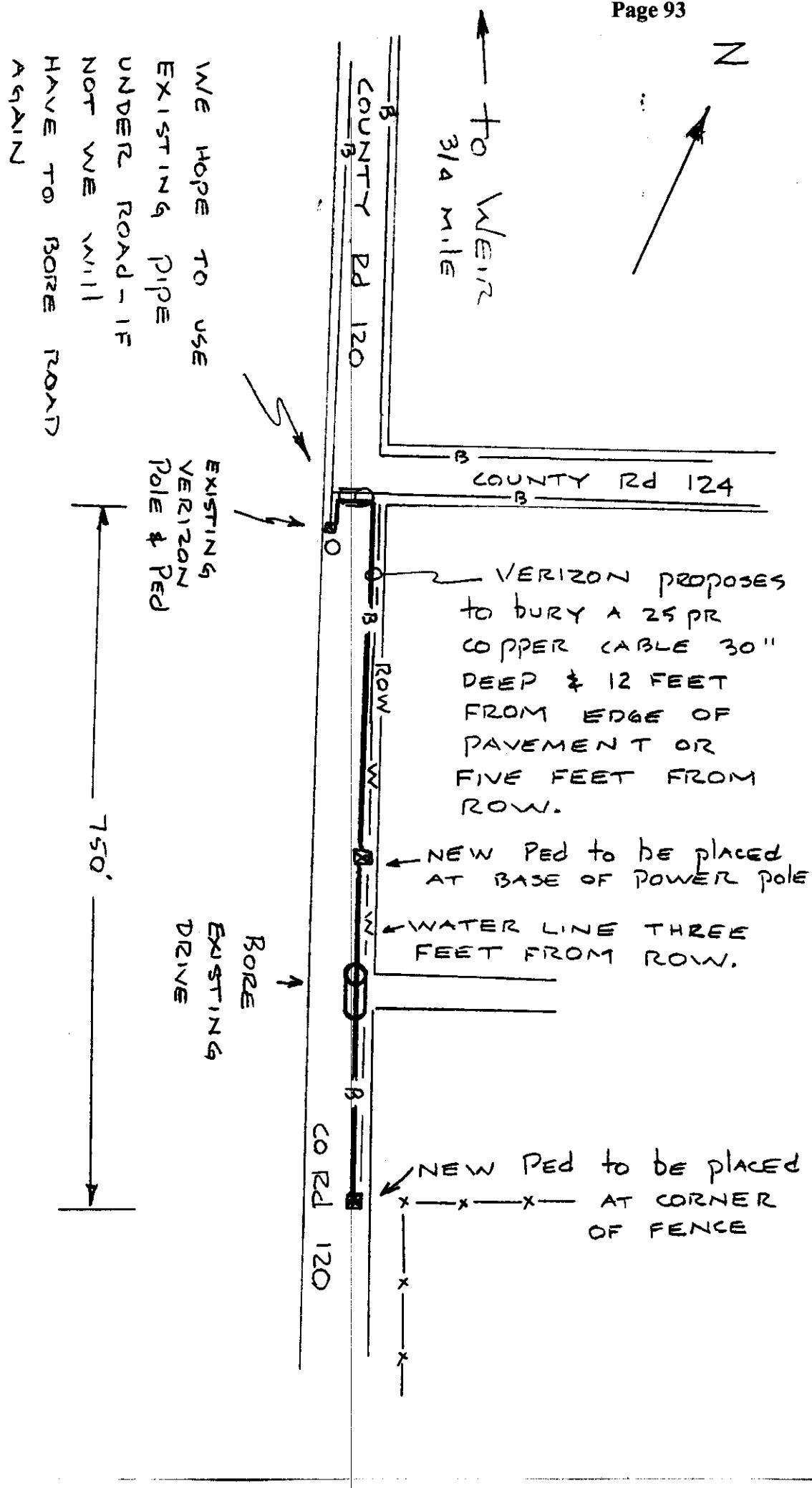


