Consider proposed release of abandoned right of way.

Consider approving extension of current contract for psychiatric service for the jail with Bluebonnet Trails.

He said that two changes were made to the contract: the hourly fee for the psychiatrist has been raised from \$85 to \$90; and the County will be charged for one hour of travel time each way per visit at the rate of \$90.
