Whereas, A.C. Berry, Jr. established and implemented the case management system currently being used by all juvenile probation officers in the County; and

Whereas, A.C. Berry, Jr. serves on the Round Rock YMCA Advisory Board, Williamson County Big Brothers/Big Sisters Advisory Council, Advisory Council for S.T.A.R.R.Y and he serves as vice chairman for the Community Resource Coordination Group and President of the Children's Support Coalition; and

Hear and consider recommendation from the Williamson County Board of Health regarding County participation in a regional health care planning project.

Karen Wilson, Director of the Williamson County and Cities Health District, addressed the court concerning a regional planning effort concerning health care issues. The goal of the project is to identify the situation in a 5-county area as to coverage and availability of health care services, including preventive, primary and hospital care. She recommended that Williamson County participate in the study and asked that the County also contribute financially to the effort. She stated that Williamson County's share of the costs for a preliminary study would be \$6,000.00. The County's share of the cost for a larger project to study models of health care programs and financing of health care would be \$30,000.00.

Judge Doerfler asked that the overlap of services be considered in the study as well as gaps in services.
