Terry May of 40203 Heritage Hollow in Georgetown addressed the court concerning traffic on Heritage Hollow from the San Gabriel River RV Resort behind his neighborhood. He reminded the court that he had appeared before the court two weeks ago regarding this issue. He asked for an agenda item to address the issue and requested that a road survey be conducted on Heritage Hollow in the Pennington Place Subdivision.
