Dear Mrs. Atkinson:

On May 22, 2002 Williamson County received bids for project # 02WC426. Five bid proposals were received with bid totals ranging from \$ 373,586.20 to \$466,678.85. The apparent low bidder was Ellis-McGinnis Construction Company from Eddy, Texas. A tabulation of the bids received is attached.

HDR has reviewed the bid proposal submitted by Ellis-McGinnis Construction Co, contacted their references, and documented their experience as it relates to this project. Their bid is accurate and complete. Responses from references are summarized as follows:

- Larry Smith P.E., TxDOT Eastland Area Engineer: Has worked with Ellis-McGinnis on several off-system bridge projects, and gave a positive recommendation.
- Richard Brown P.E. TxDOT Gatesville Area Engineer: Has worked with Ellis-McGinnis on off-system bridge projects, and gave a positive recommendation.
- Marc McEndree P.E., TxDOT Stephenville Area Engineer: Has worked with Ellis-McGinnis on off-system bridge projects, and gave a positive recommendation.
- John Wagner, P.E., TxDOT Georgetown Area Engineer: Worked with Ellis McGinnis on one off-system bridge project, and gave a positive recommendation.

We contacted Linda Edwards, who is the representative of the insurance company that provided the Bid Bond. Ms. Edwards was comfortable issuing the construction bond to Ellis-McGinnis if they were declared the winning bidder.

Additionally, we obtained a Dun and Bradstreet Business Information Report for Ellis-McGinnis Construction Co. as part of our review. The report gives the company a "strong" financial condition rating, and a "clear" financial history, with a solid payment history to suppliers. A copy of the report is included for your review.



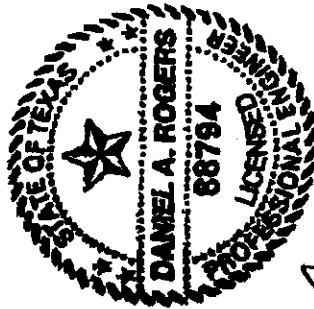
