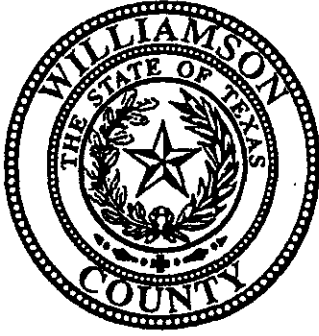

Williamson County Unified Road & Bridge System (URS) shall determine crushing locations and amount of material required at each location. Crushing locations include but are not limited to Tract 105, U.S. Government, U.S. Army Corp of Engineers property at Lake Georgetown. Awarded Bidder will stockpile material or load into county trucks as specified by individual location requirements.

Awarded Bidder will be responsible for all permits, licenses, and inspections necessary to comply with applicable laws and regulations. Awarded Bidder will abide by the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (T.N.R.C.C.) and U.S. Army Corp of Engineer rules.

The U.S. Army Corp of Engineers reserves the right to postpone or cancel the proposed activities for any reason. In the event the activity must be postponed or cancelled, the U.S. Army Corp of Engineers and Williamson County will not be held liable for any mobilization or demobilization costs incurred by the awarded bidder.

Equipment and techniques used will be standard for this type of work. No blasting will be permitted. All personnel, equipment, supplies, and materials will be furnished by the awarded bidder.

Work will be limited to the area immediately surrounding the spoil piles. Vehicle access to the work site will be limited to ingress and egress along established routes. The County is authorized to place locks and gates as necessary for access to the work area, provided that 24-hour access to the work area by the U.S. Army Corp of Engineers is not impeded. Gates will be kept closed at all times that active hauling is not in progress for the safety of the general public, and the County will post and maintain signs limiting ingress and egress to authorized personnel only. Haul trucks and other heavy equipment will not be permitted across the dam road. Following completion of work the site shall be restored by Williamson County.

No activities will be conducted between the hours of 10:00 pm and 6:00 am unless approved in writing by Williamson County.

This bid does not convey any rights or privileges other than those specifically stated. The U.S. Government, U.S. Army Corp of Engineers, and Williamson County shall not be held liable for any damages to property, persons, or wildlife related directly or indirectly to this activity. The U.S. Government, U.S. Army Corp of Engineers, and Williamson County will not be responsible for any fees or other expenses incurred by any party as a result of this activity.

Awarded Bidder shall provide to Williamson County proof of insurance coverage of operations in an amount not less than \$1,000,000.00.

CRUSHING ROCK MATERIAL FOR URS

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Williamson County Unified Road System shall have the right to change any specifications on processed materials at any time during the crushing process. The awarded bidder shall be notified in writing within 48 hours of any such change.

Crushed rock materials are to be crushed to a gradation equivalent to Type A, Grade 4, Flexible Base as specified by the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDot) Specifications, Item No. 247, with the following gradation:

#4	50 – 75%
#40	70 – 85%

The crusher shall be capable of handing 30" material and crush a minimum of 230 yards per day, any material too large will be stockpiled away and will remain in the stockpile area.

All equipment and personnel for the crushing operation and loading of trucks shall be supplied by the awarded bidder and included in your bid.

Williamson County shall cross section stockpile(s) to determine exact quantities.

Material loaded into county trucks will be calculated by the cubic yard.

BID IS TO BE BASED ON A PER CUBIC YARD PRICE.

Our price for providing all equipment and labor to produce the above material is Two Dollars and Ninety Cents (\$2.90) per cubic yard as measured in stockpile.
